Dear Families,

Our Halloween party was a huge success! The children really enjoyed showing off their customs to their friends. We had a variety of activities to do, such as: carving the Room Aa pumpkin, playing with the pumpkin guts (pulp), Bozo buckets, witch hat ring toss, and decorating spooky bags to take all their goodies home. We listened to some spooky music as well. We are thrilled with how well our students are doing with number and letter recognition.

Last month:

Art: Each child has traced and colored the letter of the week, as well as created a craft based on the letter or theme. For example, we have made handprint mail people, dinosaur eggs, brown bear-brown bear, and many spooky creatures.

Language Arts: Students continue to recognize and print the letter of the week on a whiteboard each day. Last month's letters we learned to recognize, trace, and write were Bb, Cc, Dd, Ee, and Ff. We also learned the sounds that the letters make, and words that begin with each letter. Also, the children can identify images starting with the letter of the week. We continue to trace our names as well.

Math/Science: We introduced new numbers 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 to students through our daily calendar lesson by recognizing and writing the number of the week. In science, we learned about what friends do to help their community, different cultures, dinosaur's environment, and watch our magic starfish grow in water.

Motor skills: We are enhancing our fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination through cutting projects, as well as tracing and writing our worksheets, painting, and drawing projects. We continue to learn how to correctly hold a pair of scissors and a writing utensil.

During group activities: We learned about how friends help their community and learned the diverse cultures around the world, as well as around our classroom.

This month we will focus on:

November 6th – 10th Theme: Farm, Letter: Gg, and Number: 7.

November 13th – 17th Theme: Dental, Letter: Hh, and Number: 8.

November 20th – 24th Theme: Thanksgiving, Letter Review: Aa - Hh, Number Review: 1 – 8.

November 27th – December 1st Theme: Insects, Letter Ii, and Number: 9.
