The children have been doing a fantastic job with our Phonics reading and language arts unit. They enjoy fun activities that involve practicing tracing and writing our letters such as bringing in mystery bags and our end of the unit picture dictionary pages. This month, we will continue with the letters Ll. Ii, and Tt. We continue to work on properly holding a pencil.

The pre-kindergarten children learned how to write and recognize numbers 6-8. They also reviewed how to write and recognize numbers 1-5. The Jr. K/Kk children learned how to add using their fingers. This month, the pre-kindergarten children will learn how to write and recognize numbers 9-10 as well as review 1-10. The Jr. K/Kk children will learn how to subtract by using pictures to help them.

We had a blast learning about outer space in science. We learned about the moon and the solar system through the pretend outer space field trip we took. This month, we will learn about the weather. We will also learn about the seasons and what clothes to wear for each season and what changes we see and feel outside.

October was very exciting for the children. They enjoyed learning about community helpers. They did various art projects which helped them learn through self-expression. They also had fun using their manners and learning basic safety tips for Halloween through role playing. This month, we will begin our study of maps and reading simple directions.
