

## Room Aa November Newsletter



Dear Families,

Our Halloween party was a huge success! The children really enjoyed showing off their costumes to their friends and teachers. We had a variety of activities to do, such as carving the Room Aa pumpkin, playing with the pumpkin guts (pulp), "Pumpkin" Bowling, witch hat ring toss, playing what's in the water table, and decorating spooky bags to take all their goodies home. We listened to some spooky music as well.

We are thrilled with how well our students are doing with number and letter recognition.

## Last month:

Art: Each child has traced and colored the letter of the week, as well as created a craft based on the letter or theme. For example, we have made handprint Pokémon based on letters, made checker boards, dinos with hands as spikes, used watercolors, painted cow plates and so much more!

<u>Language Arts</u>: Students continue to recognize and print the letter of the week on a whiteboard each day. Lasts month's letters we learned to recognize, trace, and write were Ee, Ff, Gg, and reviewed the letters Aa-Gg. We also learned the sounds that the letters make, and words that begin with each letter. Also, the children can identify images starting with the letter of the week. We continue to trace our names as well.

<u>Math/Science</u>: We introduced new numbers 5, 6, and 7 and reviewed the numbers 1-7 to students through our daily calendar lesson by recognizing and writing the number of the week. In science, we learned about the work a farmer and his animals do and how games can help us grow closer and have fun together.

<u>Motor skills:</u> We are enhancing our fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination through cutting projects, as well as tracing and writing our worksheets, painting, and drawing projects. We continue to learn how to correctly hold a pair of scissors and a writing utensil.

## This month we will focus on:

November 3<sup>rd</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> Theme: Hibernation, Letter: Hh, and Number: 8.

November 10<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> Theme: Insect, Letter: Ii, and Number: 9.

November 17<sup>th</sup> - November 21<sup>st</sup> Theme: Jungle, Letter Jj, and Number: 10.

November 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> Theme: Thanksgiving, Letter Review: Hh - Jj, Number Review: 8 – 10.
