April Recap:

ART: We continue to trace and color the letter of the week and transform into something awesome, along with our different themes of the week art projects.

MATH: The children continue to work on number recognition and rote counting of numbers 1-20 as well learning basic addition & subtraction. They are doing an amazing job!

LANGUAGE ARTS: We are doing a fantastic job at reciting the letters of the alphabet and the sounds they make. We continue to use white boards to practice printing our names, letters, numbers, basic addition, and subtraction problems, as well as sounding out our sight words and writing them on our whiteboards.
