Here is a recap of February:

Art: Each child has traced, written, and colored the letter of the week while also creating a craft based on the letter. We have made different fairytales, restaurant/Valentine's, music, and nursery rhymes projects.

Language Arts: We continue to master our alphabet by finding the letter of the week and pointing it out in our books. We also recite the letter and create the sound that the letter makes. Last month, we learned to recognize, trace, and write the letters Kk, Ll, Mm, & Nn. We use laminated labels to practice tracing our first name with dry erased markers. These activities help enhance our writing skills as well as build our fine motor skills.

Math/Science/Literature: We continue to work on concepts such as grouping, matching, sorting, measuring, counting, tracing, and writing numbers. Last month, we learned the numbers 6 & 7. In Science, we learned the difference between fiction and nonfiction stories and how different instruments make sounds.
