## April Recap:

**ART:** We continue to trace and color the letter of the week and transform it into something awesome, along with our different themes of the week's art projects.

**LANGUAGE ARTS:** We continue to master our alphabet by finding the letter of the week and pointing it out in our books. We also recite the letter and create the sound that the letter makes. Last month, we learned to recognize and trace the letters Ss, Tt, Uu, & Vv. We continue to use laminated dry erased name tags to practice tracing our names. These activities help enhance our writing skills as well as build our fine motor skills. We started learning Spanish during circle time. Singing a Spanish morning song and learning how to say the days of the week, months of the year, and counting in Spanish.

**MATH/SCIENCE:** The children continue to work on number recognition and rote counting of numbers 1-10. They are doing an awesome job! We have observed and predicted different fun science experiments this month like predicting the weather, making a tornado using 2-liter bottles (added food coloring and glitter), which objects will float or sink, and watching colors mix together with markers and water. We are learning about plants and will be observing how long it will take our seeds to grow.
